God has been actively working through A Safe Place during these past few months since you last heard from us!

We have been able to regularly serve over 100 homeless friends each month. Recently 15 of our homeless friends have obtained jobs and a room or apartment. In the past two months, five new volunteers have partnered with us, with two of the women also joining our Board of Directors. And now, with the active Crooks wildfire, we are assisting those being displaced from the open lands.

The Park Collective is now open in Prescott Valley and welcomes our homeless friends, as do both the Prescott Valley and Prescott Libraries. The Prescott Valley Library even maintains a food pantry for all in need.

Through the generosity of our partners, A Safe Place has been able to provide the following services as needed:

- Nonperishable food
- Toiletries and hand sanitizer
- Seasonal clothing (socks, gloves, hats, jackets)
- Over the counter medicines
- Clothing vouchers from Stepping Stones
- Laundry vouchers
- Shower vouchers
- Pet food
- Sleeping bags, blankets, tents, and backpacks
- Towels and washcloths
- Blessing Bags (an assortment of items carried and distributed by our volunteers as needs arise)
- Job publications
- An address
- Computer help with applications and forms
- Referrals to ministry partners
- Bibles, Christian literature, tracts
- Prayer
- Listening to our friends' personal stories
- Agape love
