Throughout the summer, A Safe Place continued to encounter new people experiencing homelessness and through God's provision, has been able to serve them with much needed food, water, various toiletries hygiene products, laundry services, job leads, assistance with accessing various services, and most importantly, sharing the hope of the gospel and prayer.

We continue to pray for our homeless friend "Mary", who we met recently in a local park. She had given up on her situation, but with prayer and encouragement, Mary decided that she would again try to get out of her cycle of homelessness. In our conversations with her, she indicated a need for counseling, and we were able to assist in arranging this. We have maintained a personal relationship with Mary over the last few months. She is now attending church at Park Collective and has obtained work at a local store. Mary is well on her way to regaining independence through many prayers with her and for her.

As we head into the cold weather months, A Safe Place relies on the support of our friends to ensure we have survival items readily available such as sleeping bags, blankets, and tents, warm clothing and socks, jackets, hats, and gloves. With prices continuing to rise, it also becomes more challenging for us to obtain the non-perishable single serve foods, over-the-counter health items, toiletries, and personal hygiene products that we regularly share with those in need. Your support of this ministry enables us to engage one-on-one with homeless individuals in our community and share the gospel message of God's love and hope for eternal life.
