The long, cold winter is a distant memory with the record-breaking summer heat. Extreme weather conditions are especially hard for the unhoused. And the continued high price of gas adds to the challenges of daily living for those whose only shelter is their vehicle.

We invite you to join us in support of this ministry, especially now. The warmer weather, as always, is increasing the number of people we encounter, increasing our costs to meet even the most pressing needs. If you would like to make an **in-kind donation** of needed items, call or email us to arrange for pick-up/drop-off. Currently we are accepting: individual serving sized non-perishable food items (examples: individual size cans of Chef Boyardee or similar; canned tuna or chicken; ramen cups; pudding cups; fruit cups; individual cracker packets; granola or breakfast bars; individual packets of trail mix or nuts; individual packets of cheese and crackers; etc.); bottles of water; single serving size Gatorade or similar; small bottles of body wash, shampoo, conditioner; hygiene wipes. (Note, we cannot accept clothing, toothbrushes, or toothpaste at this time.)

We also invite you to join us in **directly serving** the homeless population in the immediate area. We are **seeking additional Field Volunteers** who, in teams of two, drive our van on various routes through the local business areas and parks on weekday mornings talking and praying with our friends as we provide food, toiletries, towels, wash cloths, laundry, shower and clothing vouchers, Bibles and tracts. Most importantly, we also pray for and with our friends. The typical time served lasts 3-4 hours.
