## **Volunteer Roles**

We appreciate our volunteers! We know it is only through volunteer support that A Safe Place can operate.

Our volunteers have a heart for serving, can quickly develop a rapport with strangers; demonstrate empathy, compassion, humility, integrity; develop relationships yet maintain personal boundaries; are comfortable sharing the gospel of Jesus and praying with those served, and gladly pitch in with whatever is needed. If that sounds like you, read on...

**FIELD VOLUNTEERS** work as part of a 2-person street-outreach team on our van, going out into the community on a regularly scheduled basis throughout the year to directly serve homeless individuals found in parking lots, local parks, or other known locations. The van carries an array of survival items including food, beverages, hygiene items, clothing, tents, sleeping bags, etc. and a resource guide that is used to help direct people to other needed assistance available in the community. They engage in conversation, get to know the person's story, provide encouragement, share the gospel and pray with the person as allowed. Volunteers are also responsible for loading and unloading the van and restocking supplies.

**DROP-IN CENTER (DIC) VOLUNTEERS** work as part of a 3 - 4-person team in the Drop-In Center on a regularly scheduled basis to engage with and serve individuals in need who are experiencing homelessness when these individuals stop in. The Drop-In Center exists to provide a sheltered place for fellowship, refreshment, getting assistance with finding or accessing various resources available in the community, as well as access to a computer. Meals are served, showers are available, and various supplies are available including food items, beverages, vouchers for laundry, reading material, and the listening ear of a friendly volunteer is always available. On scheduled days, hot meals are served, an advocate is available onsite to assist with housing and shelter needs, and an on-site chaplain is available. Volunteers are also responsible for restocking, cleaning, laundering towels, warming and serving meals, explaining and enforcing rules, and light administrative duties associated with running the facility day-to-day.

Note: volunteers can be trained to serve in either or both roles. These are general descriptions and do not describe all duties or requirements. For more information or to receive an application form, please contact us
